International Application Step-by-Step Guide

STEP 1	Receive Offer Letter If you are eligible to enroll for your chosen course, UMPSA representative will send to you a offer letter and other related documents for enrolment.
STEP 2	Apply for your Visa Apply for a Student Pass directly through the EMGS website at the following address: https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/five-steps-to-study-in-malaysia/ and/or https://visa.educationmalaysia.gov.my/ .
