International Application Step-by-Step Guide

STEP 1	<h3>Pre-Arrival Arrangements</h3> <p>Upon receipt of your visa approval letter (VAL) you are required to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Obtain Single Entry Visa (SEV) - [if required]. Contact the Embassy or Consular of Malaysia in your country to make an application; or apply online through Malaysia eVisa website: https://malaysiavisa.imi.gov.my/evisa/evisa.jsp • Arrange your own accommodation in Malaysia prior to your activation as a UMPSA student; • Inform university about arrival date to Malaysia in advance by emailing a Copy of the Flight Ticket to the Visa Unit, Academic Services minimum 7 days prior to arrival. Kindly be informed that students will be charged a penalty for late arrival notification to Visa Unit. • Enter Malaysia maximum 1 week prior to your course registration date. • Make sure to bring documents for registration days such as offer letter, passport, academic transcripts and certificates; • You are required to complete Malaysia Digital Arrival Card (MDAC) min 3 days prior to your intended date of travel. - Students are advised to proceed to Immigration counter. You should present the following documents to the Immigration check-point at the airport to get your entry stamp:
 1. eVAL
 2. eVisa or SEV
 3. Offer letter
 4. Original passport
 5. MDAC
- Upon presenting the required documents, immigration will issue you with a Special Pass and you may proceed to collect your luggage from the carousel.
- For your information, UMPSA does not provide airport pick-up service at KLIA. Students are required to make their own arrangements to travel to UMPSA. Kindly refer <https://maps.app.goo.gl/d5uM3f8BQWLXRtb98> for the guides to reach the UMPSA Gambang campus (for registration).

- Kindly report yourself to the Academic Services on the next working day of your arrival in Malaysia (refer email for date of registration). Failure to report within time may cause your visa problem.
- Medical Check-Up: Students are required to undergo medical screening at the UMPSA panel clinic (Kuantan or Pekan, Pahang State) after report to Academic Services. A list of panel clinics is available below. The complete medical report will have to get verification from the UMPSA Medical Officer at the University Health Centre (PKU). The cost to undergo a health checkup at the relevant clinic/hospital is around **MYR260 to MYR307**.
